

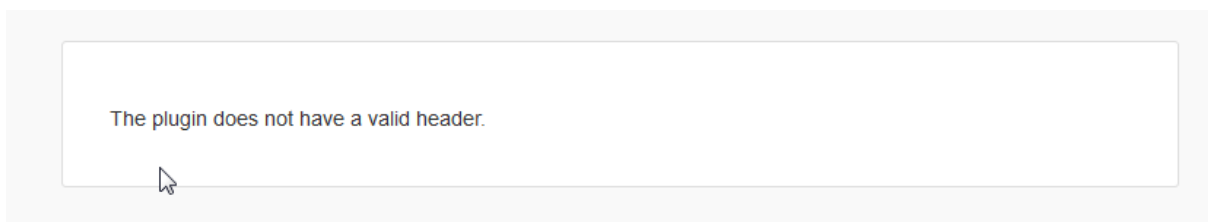
## Setting Up WP SlidePro

WP SlidePro is very easy to install and setup. In this Tutorial, I will explain how you can setup and use WP SlidePro. Once you install and activate WP SlidePro, you can find the setting of WP SlidePro under the settings option.

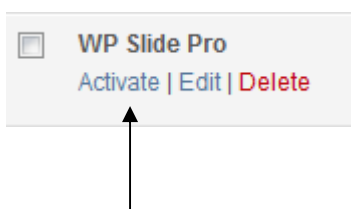
### Step 1 - Upload and Install

1- Upload WP SlidePro using zip file method from plugin dashboard page

\*Note in some browsers you may experience a condition after you install and try to activate WP SlidePro where you might receive the following message.




If you do receive this message during the activation step just click on the back button click on installed plugins and activate the plugin from within the plugin list as shown below. The plugin will now be activated, we are working on an update to compensate for this problem but the plugin will work fine.



### Step 2 - Once activated just follow these steps...




Note...Once you click on the WP SlidePro settings link you will be prompted to enter an access code in-order to use your copy of WP SlidePro. Just enter the paypal email address you used to make your purchase with into the access code field and click on validate app. From here you can move onto the settings page and begin your setup.

After clicking on settings tab you will be taken to the WP SlidePro Setting's page from where you can setup each social media tab according to your needs. Every social network has its own setup tab that is pretty straight forward to follow as you can see.

You have the option to display a particular network by checking the tick box and filling in the applicable details of your profile on that particular network. This will enable the plugin to fetch your updates and automatically show up in your sliders. For example if I want to enable the Facebook Updates on my blog this is how you would set it up.

Here is what you will need to activate any network:

**Activating Facebook:** To activate and display Facebook Updates on your blog, you can go to Facebook Tab and enter your Facebook Page URL. You can also customize the design of this button by changing the width, height and top settings to fit your needs.

**Activating Twitter:** To activate and display Tweets on your blog, you can go to Twitter Tab and enter your Twitter Username. You can also customize the design of this button as well as specifying how many tweets you want to display along with option to show the follow button or not.

**Activating G+:** This one requires a few more steps to set up. To activate and display G+ feeds on your blog, you need to go to the G+ Tab and enter your G+ page id. Remember, you should not enter the complete URL of your profile but just the id. You can also customize the design of this button. Once you are done with this, you will need to setup a cronjob to allow the plugin to fetch your G+ updates as G+ does not have an API interface in place as of the day of this guide. Setting up a cronjob is simple and you can refer to the step 3 below for setting up a CronJob for G+ below.

**Activating LinkedIn:** To activate and display LinkedIn updates on your blog, you can go to the LinkedIn Tab and enter your LinkedIn Profile URL. You can also customize the design of this button.

**Activating Youtube:** To activate and display Youtube Videos on your blog, you can go to Youtube Tab and enter your Youtube Channel Name. You can also customize the design of this button.

### Step 3 - Setting up a Cronjob for your Google Plus Slider

To be able to display the G+ tab on your blog using WP SlidePro you will need to setup a cronjob. A Cronjob is a free tool that is available within your hosting cpanel. A Cronjob is a job scheduler that you predefine when you want particular events to run. We want to schedule the fetching of G+ updates from your G+ page at certain times throughout the day.


So to create a cronjob just follow these steps:

- 1) Locate and click on the CronJob icon in your hosting cpanel dashboard.



## 2) Adding your cronjob
